Kirby Lester's compact new KL1 tablet counter weighs 6 pounds and is 6" wide by 12" high, making it a compelling option for space-constrained pharmacies.

The tablet counter can process 15 to 18 tablets per second and can count any size of tablet or capsule up to 22 mm in length. It features a partial pill indicator that maintains filling integrity and an inventory mode that keeps count when the tray is being emptied.
